OCTOBER is the month of the ROSARY in part because the feast of the Holy Rosary, (originally the Feast of Our Lady of Victory) was instituted by Pope Pius V after the defeat of the Turkish fleet at Lepanto on October 7th, 1571. The victory was attributed to the praying of the Rosary, by the Catholics of Europe as requested by the Pope.

Many Popes have promoted the Rosary; John Paul II wrote an apostolic letter on the Rosary in 2002 and added the five Luminous Mysteries. In a recent audience, Pope Benedict stated, "The traditional image of the Madonna of the Rosary depicts Mary holding the child Jesus in her arm and giving the Rosary to St. Dominic. This significant iconography shows that the Rosary is a means given by the Virgin for contemplating Jesus and, meditating on his life, for loving and following him always more faithfully" (Oct. 7, 2007).

THANKS FOR THE PRAYERS FOR VOCATIONS

I want to thank parishioners for persevering in prayer for vocations, especially during this year of priesthood. The Archbishop has asked ALL the parishes in Ottawa to recite our diocesan prayer for vocations every Sunday, so this is not a private initiative of our parish. Currently, we have 5 men in formation: Jonathan Kelly in philosophy at St. Philip's Seminary in Toronto, 3 more at St. Augustine's in Toronto: Hermy-Jasmin Nemorin (1st year), Matthew Keshwah (2nd year) and Hezuk Shroff (3rd year). A fifth, Matt Chojna, is assigned to St. Pat's Fallowfield for his pastoral internship year.

Every third Friday, I meet with other young men in Ottawa who are considering the call to priesthood. I am hopeful that we could have 3 or 4 more men in studies next fall.
