October is the month of the **Rosary**. In his 2002 letter on the Rosary, John Paul II offers some helpful hints to improve our own praying of the Rosary. **Listening to the Word of God:** "it is helpful to follow the announcement of the mystery with the proclamation of a related Biblical passage." **Silence:** "Just as moments of silence are recommended in the Liturgy, so too in the recitation of the Rosary it is fitting to pause briefly after listening to the word of God." **The ten "Hail Mary's":** John Paul II speaks of the "praiseworthy custom" of adding a clause to the Hail Mary referring to the mystery being contemplated (for example, in the third Joyful Mystery: "Hail Mary . . . blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus, born in Bethlehem). There are many styles of praying the Rosary. The main thing is to pray, to contemplate Jesus with Mary, to come to know Him and love Him more and more each day.

POPE BENEDICT ON VOCATIONS Speaking on the Parable of the Sower, the Pope said, "The earth is above all the heart of every person, especially of youth . . . a heart that is often confused and disoriented, yet capable of containing unimaginable powers of generosity. It is like a bud ready to open to a life spent for the love of Jesus, able to follow him with the totality and the certainty that comes from having found the greatest treasure that exists. It is always and only the Lord who sows in human hearts" (July 4th, 2009).

Pierre Lemieux as a practicing Catholic and member of Parliament that values life from conception to natural death, feels that this Bill represents the antithesis of what we believe as Catholics-it is a complete disregard for the sanctity of human life.
