**Looking before me, what do I see?** I see the children of the Lord gathered as a faith community to celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent. **Today's First Reading from the Book of Genesis** involved the divine calling of Abraham to become the spiritual father of the people of God. Without the fiat of

Having been blessed by the free grace of the Heavenly Father, the atoning sacrifice of the Lord Jesus, and the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit, we owe our gratitude to our spiritual father, Abraham. ## Today's Second Reading from the Second Letter of

**Timothy** is a reminder that God calls each and every one of us. God wants us to become holy, reminding us that we have received our life and immortality through the gospel. Therefore, we are called to "Join... in suffering for the gospel.

During today's reading from the Gospel of Matthew,

we heard that in the company of Peter, James and his brother John, Jesus transfigured on a high mountain. My brothers and sisters in Christ, today's three readings remind us that the Heavenly Father sent His only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, so we may be saved through the grace and mercy of a loving God who never abandoned us. Before we were created, the Lord God called us with a holy calling. Through Christ, He showed us the way, the truth and the life.

**Instituted by Christ Himself,** the holy catholic church commands us to prepare ourselves for the great Feast of Easter that approaches. So we may be holy on that day as Jesus is holy, we are called to repent of our sins and receive the sacrament of confession. Then, having been made righteous in Christ, the Lord God will no longer remember our sins. And having been raised to a state of holiness, we will all qualify to join together in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist on Easter Sunday.
