

This fall, OLMM is offering Catechesis of the Good **Shepherd** (CGS) Level 1 for children aged 3-5 years old (born in 2012, 2013, 2014) and Level 2 for 6-8 years old (born in 2009, 2010, 2011). CGS is a Montessori approach to sharing the Christian faith with children. Together with trained catechists, children will listen to and wonder about scripture, and be engaged in elements of the Church in a space called the atrium.
