Blessed be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for He has shown us His merciful love!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Blessed Trinity, one of the greatest feasts of our faith! The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches: "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is, therefore, the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the 'hierarchy of the truths of faith.'" (CCC No. 234)

In God's Image

Although we may not be able to fully understand the mystery of the Blessed Trinity, the feast itself is a powerful reminder of who we are – that we are made in the image and likeness of God and are called to imitate the love, communion, unity, and oneness of the Trinity. As members of one family of God, we must live our lives in such a way that the love of the Trinity must be felt in our homes, in our parish community, in our society and indeed in our world.

Solemnity of Corpus Christi

Next Sunday is the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, the heart and soul of our faith! In the sacrament of the Eucharist, Jesus gave us the highest and the greatest gift: the gift of Himself. The CGS team is looking for Bibles of different languages. Bibles can be dropped off in the marked box in the foyer.

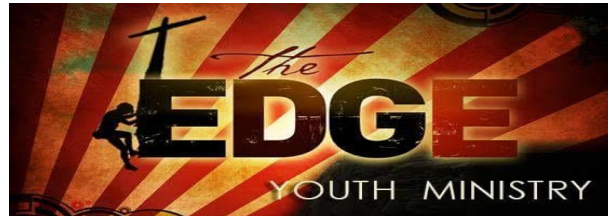
OLMM Spiritual Library Do you have Catholic newspapers or magazines that you would like to recycle? The Spiritual Library committee has placed a basket in the library to collect such items and make them available to other parishioners. Please take advantage of this service.

Religious articles from the Holy land will be on sale next weekend (June 17/18) after all masses in the hall.

This fall, OLMM is offering Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) Level 1 for children aged 3-5 years old (born in 2012, 2013, 2014) and **Level 2** for 6-8 years old (born in 2009, 2010, 2011). CGS is a Montessori approach to sharing the Christian faith with children. Together with trained catechists, children will listen to and wonder about scripture, and be engaged in elements of the Church in a space called the atrium. This past year we welcomed 12 children in Level 1 and 12 children in Level 2. The cost is \$150 for one child, \$100 for each additional child in the family. Payment plan options available upon request. Please pick up registration forms in the foyer or at the parish office. Space is limited. Drop off completed forms to the parish office.
