PASTOR'S CORNER

Hi my Parishioners! – I want to share something with you, about my Order, about the Salvatorian Fathers. About who we are.

The Society of the Divine Saviour (SDS), popularly known as the Salvatorians, is an international, religious, congregation of priests and brothers in the Catholic Church, founded in Rome, December 8, 1881, by Father Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan.



Today members of the Society are engaged in apostolic activities in 40 countries all over the world for example: Australia, Brazil, Canada, Poland, USA and Tanzania. We are part of a Salvatorian Family that includes religious sisters (Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Saviour) and laity (International Community of the Divine Saviour).

Salvatorian Charism; The founding charism is the specific gift of the Holy Spirit given to Fr. Francis Jordan for the Church and the world. It is rooted especially in four biblical texts that are key to his life and work. They are at the core of the charism he communicates to all Salvatorians.

"And eternal life is this: to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent" (John 17:3)

"Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that, I am with you always; yes, to the end of time."

(Matthew 28:19-20)

The purpose of the Society is to strengthen, to defend and to spread the Catholic faith everywhere in so far as this is committed to it by Divine Providence. Therefore, by exercising this ecclesiastical teaching function in word and writing, it intends to achieve the end, that all people might know more and more the one true God and Him, whom He sent, Jesus Christ. DEVELOPMENT & PEACE FALL CAMPAIGN LAUNCH SEPTEMBER 10, 2017 WOMEN AT THE HEART OF PEACE: MAY PEACE BE WITH HER

Societies where women and men enjoy greater equality, are more peaceful and stable, according to our new campaign resources.
In 1915, the International Congress of Women
presented U.S. President Wilson with many of the
14 points he took to the 1925 Versailles Peace talks,
which ended World War I. Over history, women have challenged militarism, opposed nuclear weapons & weapons of mass destruction, & led communities to protect their natural resources, at the cost of their lives. In South Africa, women led efforts to plan, develop, and implement the Truth & Reconciliation Commission, which helped to transition the country from an aparthied colonial government to an inclusive intercultural political system.

Here, in Canada's Indigenous communities, women are entrusted with knowledge to care for the environment, their families, and communities as an interconnected whole. When women are included in peace-building resolutions, the chances for peaceful outcomes for entire communities increase.
