? What is the Rite of Election/Calling Candidates to Lenten Renewal ?

The rite that is called the rite of acceptance into the order of catechumens is the first step and is of the utmost importance. Assembling publicly for the first time, the candidates who have completed the period of the precatechumenate declare their intention to the Church and the Church in turn, carrying out its apostolic mission, accepts them as persons who intend to become its members.

After the celebration of the rite of acceptance, the names of the catechumens are inscribed in the register of catechumens, along with the names of the sponsors and the minister and date and place of the celebration. The sponsors also attend in order to present to the Church the candidates they have brought.

Joined to the Church, the catechumens are now part of the household of Christ.

Everyone is encourage to attend this important celebration at the Notre Dame Cathedral on Sunday, March 5^{th} at 3 pm.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, Mar. 1st and ends with the beginning of the Mass of the Lord's Supper in the evening on Holy Thurs., Apr. 13th.
