#### NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners.

Our diocesan vicar general, Msgr. Kevin Beach, has recently updated us on the Clergy Retirement Fund.

Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal portion of the Fund was \$14,737.00. We raised \$7,330.00 leaving a balance of \$7,407.00. The Archdiocese has no other way of raising this money; therefore, I believe that our parish has an obligation to at least attempt to pay the remainder.

In discussion with our Temporal Affairs Committee and our accountants, we agreed that our parish would pay it over two years, in 8 quarterly payments. We already pay the diocese \$5,488.00 each quarter; now we will be adding another \$800.00. I will pledge to personally cover one of these payments, but that still leaves \$5600! We will not have any other special collection, but we will be counting on your generous weekly donations, enabling us to meet our commitments to the diocese and to continue to thrive as a parish.
