THE WAY OF THE CROSS is to follow Jesus. This devotion was originally brought back from the Holy Land by pilgrims who had meditated on Jesus' suffering as they walked from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary. After returning to their homes in Europe, some put up crosses, pictures, or statues to remind them of Holy Land shrines. The number of stations varied, but eventually the present

fourteen were accepted. Most of the stations are based on scenes from the gospel, but a few are based on legends or reflections on Christ's suffering.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS takes place *every Friday at 7 pm.* throughout Lent except on Mar. 2nd (6:30 pm.)
