Miriam Centre also reaches out with love and compassion to those suffering from the loss of a child through miscarriage, abortion or infant death, sharing their pain and helping them experience healing and peace. Other than monetary donations Miriam Centre collects Canadian Tire Money and used stamps. In our parish you can drop these off at the CWL Bulletin Board in the basement. Also, the money collected in the Alms for the Poor box from October to December will go to Miriam Centre.
