I would like to share with you this letter from our Archbishop:

Dear Fr. Tim

Thank you for the brochure you sent me on the *Archconfraternity of Prayer for the Conversion of Sinners*, and for your request that your parish formally join this Archconfraternity (in addition to individual parishioners signing up on their own).

I see from the brochure that the Archconfraternity is an association that honours the Immaculate Heart of Mary and intercedes for the conversion of sinners. I support any initiative that promotes conversion! It seems to me that the minimal responsibilities of the members make it possible for almost any parishioner to join: to pray every day at least one "Hail Mary" for the conversion of sinners, to participate in the life of the Church, and as frequently as possible to attend the Eucharist on First Saturdays.

You have my blessing for your parish to proceed and for Our Lady of the Miraculous Member to formally join the Archconfraternity of Prayer for the Conversion of Sinners.
