Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we look forward to our holy hour on March 7th, I would like to share with you this reflection:

"Every moment that we spend in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament will leave our soul everlastingly more glorious and beautiful in heaven, because the blessed sacrament is Jesus, our Risen Savior, with all the glory and beauty of his Resurrection flowing out on those who come into his Eucharistic presence.

Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the easiest person in the world to be with. Even if you cannot pray very well, or even if you do not say anything at all, the mere fact that you come to him in the Blessed Sacrament is, in itself, a prayer of faith that will greatly benefit your soul.
