Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this Sunday for the Development and Peace collection, and in follow-up to Mark Lalonde's presentation last Sunday, I would like to say a few words about my upcoming Mission trip (not yet booked!) to El Salvador and Honduras. As many of you know, I have been to El Salvador six times, but I have decided to also visit Honduras, since I have heard from the people at Canadian Food for Children that this particular mission can offer excellent opportunities for youth to serve our poor brothers and sisters in the "Third World." If all goes well, we can look ahead to planning a parish mission trip in 2009.

Every year I have been to El Salvador I hand out money to many of the poor families I have come to know over the years, many of whom had children who spent time in the local hospital for malnourished children. We have also given donations in the past to the nearby orphanage. If anyone were to entrust a donation to me, I will gladly pass it on to the poor. I am currently emailing a sister in El Salvador to ask her about other ways we could help.

I would also like to share with you that it is always a difficult decision for me to actually get up and go on a mission trip. It is easier to stay home, or lay on a beach in Cancun and have the poor serve us! But I know I wouldn't be happy doing that, and every time I do try to reach out to the poor, the Lord blesses me with more life, joy and gratitude for what He has given to me. I will keep you posted.
