In my visits to Central America, I am always deeply moved by the number of beautiful children! In Canada, by comparison, it seems we have so few children. At least in El Salvador and Honduras, hungry children have a chance to live; whereas the children we abort in our own country have no chance to live.

As you have been so generous in giving to the poor through this mission, I ask you also to be generous with your time in defending the poorest of the poor of our society - unborn children.
