Making a Will - A Lasting Legacy Please consider a gift to your Parish in your will as a lasting and beneficial testimony of faith. My brothers and sisters in Christ,

Once again I ask for your prayers in my new position as (part-time) vocations director for our diocese. We have not had a vocations director for many years, so the Archbishop's decision to appoint me is a sign that he is taking vocations seriously. Indeed, with the arrival of our new bishop last year, a wind of change began to sweep through our diocese. The youth are beginning to realize that the bishop is interested in them, that the Church needs them, that God is calling them! - and more young men and women are prayerfully considering a vocation to priesthood or religious life. The vocations are out there! However, many youth struggle with the thought of life-long commitment. I believe they need some extra grace to "push" them gently to make the leap of faith and say "yes" to God. And for that, they need the help of your prayers.

Our Archbishop has expressed the hope that one fruit of the Eucharistic Congress in our diocese would be an increase in adoration for vocations. I am still experimenting with the best time to offer adoration. Someone suggested Tuesday evening before Mass, from 6-7 p.m., and we could also extend our Friday morning adoration (currently only 15 minutes).

Please do pray for vocations and for priests! Fr. Alexis-Louis Mangin, the founder of the Servants of Jesus and Mary in Hull, often told his parishioners that the Fourth Commandment (Honour your father and mother) obliged the lay people to pray for their priests, their spiritual fathers. Believe me, we do need the help of your prayers.

On July 13/14, our parish will be welcoming Matt Chojna to speak on vocations. He is one of four seminarians currently studying for the archdiocese of Ottawa. He is a wonderful example of a young man taking this lead with joy and enthusiasm. Let us pray that another young man from our own parish will hear and answer the call. God bless you all with a peaceful and restful summer!
