♦ **FEDERAL ELECTION 2008 GUIDE:** With a federal election campaign underway, the Social Affairs Commission of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) has issued a guide inviting Catholics to vote but to do so with discernment. The Commission encourages Catholics to become better informed about the issues, to voice their concerns with the political candidates and, most of all, to vote. ♦ **40 DAYS FOR LIFE:** is a focused pro-life campaign with a vision to access God's power through prayer, fasting, and peaceful vigil to end abortion in America. This is the second year for the North American campaign and our parish has decided to jump in and participate by asking parishioners to commit to 1 day of fasting between Sept 24th and November 2nd.
