the 40 Days for Life. In Ottawa, more than 300 people took part in the opening activities and half -way- point vigil. There are the stories of unborn babies saved from abortion. Suzanne Atkinson, a prayer warrior outside the Morgentaler abortion facility at 65 Bank Street, said that on Oct. 5, she looked up to see a young girl go into the abortuary. Atkinson recorded on the web journal that, "My heart sank. I prayed that the Lord would move in her heart... that the guardian angels of her and her unborn baby would intervene." When the young woman came back out, Atkinson assumed she had gone through with the abortion. But the young woman talked to the people in the vigil and said she had changed her mind.
