Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am writing asking for your help with pastoral care - that means visiting the sick and shut-ins. We have a small group of volunteers already, but we need more. The commitment is minimal: perhaps one hour per month on average to visit someone and often, but not always, bringing communion as well. I am also hoping that one or two people could be trained to lead a communion service. With my work as vocations director, I lack the time to visit the sick as much as I would like, so I am calling on you, the parishioners, to help with this ministry of reaching out to our sick, aged or lonely brothers and sisters. Please call the office if you are interested, and we will arrange an introductory meeting.

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

It has come to my attention that some parishioners have been receiving mailings and other materials from Fr. Nicholas Gruner, publications such as Fatima Crusader and Catholic Family News. I must emphasize that Fr. Gruner is a *suspended* priest, meaning he is not a priest in good standing and he is not permitted to celebrate the sacraments. We can trust the teaching we receive from the Pope, the bishops, and the priests in union with the bishops. We cannot trust the teachings of priests who have been suspended by their bishop or superior. Just as I would not advise Catholics to follow the teaching of Martin Luther, who was an *ex-communicated* Catholic priest, neither do I advise following the erroneous and deceitful teachings of Fr. Gruner, a suspended Catholic priest. I strongly encourage all those who may be receiving material from Fr. Gruner to remove yourselves from his mailing list, and turn instead to the trustworthy sources of Catholic teaching in the Scriptures, the Catechism, the encyclicals and homilies of the Pope, and all other teachings of the magisterium.
