LITURGY MOMENT:

They are often called the prayer of the faithful for they represent the prayers of the whole community, the Church and the world. These intercessions date to the early Church and could sometimes run to a page or more. Our Petitions remind us to be persevering in prayer, never giving up and they help us to recognize our total dependence on God. For this reason many are repeated again and again. A good practice during this prayer at the Eucharist is to pause for a short time after each intention for personal prayer. In this way the congregation has an opportunity to make this prayer their own in the silence of their hearts. It also adds greater solemnity to that part of the Liturgy as we honour and glorify God through our needs.

- ◆ PRAYER FOR THE HOLY SOULS: Throughout this month of November, let us remember to pray for all our beloved dead and all the souls in Purgatory. As a sign of our prayers, we are invited to write the names of deceased loved ones in the book of remembrance in front of the altar.
