Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I thank you for all your prayers for me during my pilgrimage to the Holy Land. I have many stories to share over the coming weeks. I also carried your intentions with me, and summarized them on a piece of paper that I inserted into the Wailing Wall. It is the holiest site in Judaism because it is the Western Wall of the ancient Temple, where Jesus and the disciples would have worshipped. The Wall is the closest, physically speaking, the Jews can come to the "Holy of Holies," where the Ark of the Covenant was located, and the Presence of God dwelt.

It makes me reflect on how blessed we are as Catholics to have the real Presence of Jesus in every Church in the world, in the "Holy of Holies" of the tabernacle, where we can bring our prayers directly to our Lord Jesus Christ.

As I return to parish life, I am grateful to everyone that makes our parish such a faith-filled and vibrant community.
