

#### **PASTOR'S CORNER**

This week I would like to share with you our bishop's appeal for the people of Japan, especially since our diocese has a personal connection with the diocese of Sendai. Here are some excerpts of our bishop's letter to the diocese:

"I invite you to pray with me for the people of Japan and, to the extent possible, come to their aid in this time of need. From 1935-1941, our sixth archbishop (1953-1966), Most Reverend Marie-Joseph Lemieux, o.p., served as the second bishop of Sendai, one of the areas most affected by recent events. He fostered relations between Ottawa and Sendai with the result that the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa began a mission in Sendai and have been present there for more than fifty years. The Archdiocese has made an initial charitable donation to relief efforts and I invite you to assist as you are able in bringing help to those who are suffering so much loss." There are of course many requests in our world for our financial aid, but as part of our Lenten almsgiving, let us do what we can for the people of Japan.
