

Today, Jesus enters Jerusalem as Messiah and king and desires to enter into our lives as the shepherd of our souls leading us to the father.

"He Humbled Himself"

Jesus' earthly life was characterized by his humility and total obedience to the Father! In today's second reading, St. Paul sang beautifully the praises of Jesus who, though, was God did not count his equality with God as something to be grasped, rather emptied himself to the point of accepting death on the cross. Paul reminds us to have the same attitude as Christ. As Christians, we are called to imitate Jesus; His humility and lowliness as a model of conduct should also characterize our lives in our parish family and our entire community.

Greater Love

Jesus entered Jerusalem to suffer and to die. His passion and death is a powerful manifestation of God's immense love for each one of us. This is what we are celebrating today and the whole of this week. God loves us and He wants us to be saved and be happy. It is for this reason that He gave up His only begotten son to die on the cross; with him, He has given us all things (Rom 8). Addressing the young people during his just concluded visit to Mexico, the Holy Father said: "He (Christ) knows us and loves us. If we allow the love of Christ to change our hearts, then we can change the world. This is the secret of authentic happiness."
