PRAYER FOR THE HOLY SOULS: Throughout this month of November, let us remember to pray for all our beloved dead and all the souls in Purgatory. As a sign of our prayers, we are invited to write the names of deceased loved ones in the book of remembrance in front of the altar.

BOOK OF LIFE: This special Parish Book of Remembrance contains the names and intentions that you would like to remember in a special way during the month of November. **ALL ARE INVITED TO COME AND ENTER A NAME IN THIS SPECIAL BOOK** where their names will be lifted up to heaven during the holy sacrifice of the Mass.

FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE: Introduction to the Nicene Creed - Part Five.

The next lines of the Creed have some unique formulations: "BORN OF THE FATHER BEFORE ALL AGES. GOD FROM GOD, LIGHT FROM LIGHT, TRUE GOD FROM TRUE GOD, BEGOTTEN, NOT MADE, CONSUBSTANTIAL WITH THE FATHER." Each of these clauses was included in the Creed to either combat a specific heresy or to clarify the Church's belief for the Christian community. The first clause "BORN OF THE FATHER BEFORE ALL AGES" was aimed at combatting the idea that Jesus was 'created'. The early Church struggled against a strain of thought that hypothesized that Jesus might be semi-divine but that he was somehow created as a 'super-angel' or that Jesus was an ordinary man who was adopted by God and then subsequently 'elevated' to a special status. The first clause makes it clear that Jesus is the Father's Son and is eternal like the Father and the Spirit. Next week we will look at the next clauses!
