

Introduction to the Nicene Creed - Part Six. It is helpful to keep in mind that every clause in the Nicene Creed is there to clarify the Church's belief or to refute a specific erroneous line of thought. "GOD FROM GOD, LIGHT FROM LIGHT, TRUE GOD FROM TRUE GOD, BEGOTTEN, NOT MADE, CONSUBSTANTIAL WITH THE FATHER," try to correct the false notion that Jesus is somehow different from the Father in terms of his 'God-ness.' At the time of the early Church when Greek philosophy provided many of the conceptual tools to talk about very abstract concepts, the idea of a hierarchy of being was very prominent. If *Jesus is the Son of God, one erroneous line of thought went,* he was therefore 'less' than his Father. The Creed tries to refute this line of thinking with these clauses to establish that Jesus is not less than the Father nor is he a creation of the Father, but rather His true Son. Sons and daughters are not 'less' than their parents!
