~YEAR OF FAITH~

Introduction to the Nicene Creed - Part Seventeen:

The final part of the Creed reads: "I LOOK FORWARD TO THE RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD AND THE LIFE OF THE WORLD TO COME." We believe that we will be raised from the dead and our souls reunited with our body when Christ returns in glory. Sometimes people like to speculate what that means or what that will look like but right now we have only a limited idea of what that will mean: "By death the soul is separated from the body, but in the resurrection God will give incorruptible life to our body, transformed by reunion with our soul. Just as Christ is risen and lives for ever, so all of us will rise at the last day" (Catechism, n. 1016). We also believe that "at the end of time, the Kingdom of God will come in its fullness. Then the just will reign with Christ for ever, glorified in body and soul, and the material universe itself will be transformed. God will then be "all in all" (1 Cor 15:28), in eternal life" (Catechism, n. 1060).
