~YEAR OF FAITH~

Introduction to the Nicene Creed -

Part Eighteen: The last word of the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed is "Amen." The word in Hebrew comes from the same root as "believe." The Catechism teaches: "thus the Creed's final "Amen" repeats and confirms its first words: "I believe." To believe is to say "Amen" to God's words, promises and commandments; to entrust oneself completely to him who is the "Amen" of infinite love and perfect faithfulness. The Christian's everyday life will then be the "Amen" to the "I believe" of our baptismal profession of faith" (n. 1064). It also makes the profound point that Jesus Christ is God's "amen" of love for us the definitive statement of God's trustworthiness and fidelity to the human family (n. 1065). And so we come full circle from our "I believe" at the beginning of the Creed to our firm assent at God's trustworthiness at the end with our "amen."

SIGN OF PEACE: In the flu and cold season people are reminded that the rite of peace does not necessarily have to be expressed by a handshake. A simple greeting is acceptable
