PASTOR'S CORNER

Since this edition of the bulletin is for the month of July, I shall try and give a brief reflection on the readings of the four Sundays therein.

14th Sunday – July 7th

The Lord is compassionate and love! Our Lord is a God who hears the cries of the poor and the needy. In today's first reading, Jerusalem is pictured as a mother, lovingly nursing her children, and it is this image that the Lord assumes for himself: "As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you." May we learn to approach him with complete trust and experience the freedom and security he offers.

15th Sunday – July 14th

Jesus is indeed the Good Samaritan! He left His heavenly throne and to take our human nature in order to bind up the wounds of sin, hatred and division. In the story of the Good Samaritan, we are reminded of what we are called to do - to look out and care for one another, anyone in need! Our love for Jesus is measured by the way we love that man, woman, child out there. A Christian properly so called is one who goes out of his or her way to help a person in need. Go and do likewise!

16th Sunday – July 21st

Both Abraham and the two sisters, Mary and Martha, opened their homes in hospitality to others: Abraham welcomed strangers, Martha and Mary welcomed a family friend, Jesus. They were hospitable. They loved God very much. Mary, however, understood that true hospitality is receiving more than giving or doing. When we open ourselves to God's self-giving and allow ourselves to be loved by him, as Mary did, it is only then that we can truly be called his disciples.

17th Sunday – July 28th

Jesus gives us a profound teaching today in which he tells us to call God "Father". The "Our Father" is a powerful reminder that in God we have a Father

who never lets us down, who is reliable, trust worthy and dependable, a Father who knows and calls each of us by name, who cares, who is always for us gracious and forgiving! May we never be afraid to call God our Father!
