The Most Reverend Terrence Prendergast, SJ, Archbishop of Ottawa, has asked Catholic parishes to conduct a special collection at all Masses in the Archdiocese of Ottawa next weekend, November 23 and 24 - to respond to the worst natural disaster to hit the Philippines in its history. Last Friday, Typhoon Haiyan forced 600,000 people from their homes, and approximately 9.5 million people are in need of aid across nine provinces. The Government of Canada has announced that it will match donations to the Typhoon Haiyan Relief Fund made by Canadians to Canadian-registered charities between November 9 and December 9. Contributions made through the Archdiocese of Ottawa for this relief effort will be eligible for the matching programme.
