

The Lord said to them, "Come follow me, and I will make you fishers of people."

### The Call

In today's gospel, Jesus summoned His first disciples, Peter and Andrew, James and John, so that they might become fishers of people, that is, to become missionaries and evangelists. These men, we are told, left **EVERYTHING** and followed Jesus. We could ask ourselves: what was it that attracted them to this man, Jesus, that made them to abandon their career, and in the case of James and John, even their father, and follow Him? We might not know what that could be. But one thing we know for sure is, in their mind, Jesus was worth following!

### The Joy of Following Jesus

Following the Lord gives us great joy! Peter and his colleagues must have experienced this tremendous joy, as they abandoned their former means of livelihood in order to follow Jesus.
