Pastor's Corner

Since this edition of the bulletin is for the month of July, I shall try to give a brief reflection on all of the readings of the whole month.

14th Sunday – July 6th

“Come to me...and I will give rest!” Our Lord Jesus offers hope and courage to all those who are open to His message. He wants us to have the fullness of life which He alone can give. He tells us to come to Him, because His yoke fits well and is not like the one that the world gives: emptiness and misery. Following Him does make radical demands, but He is always beside us to help us carry our burdens.

15th Sunday – July 13th

“Listen! A sower went out to sow!” The word of God is alive and active. It is a pure gift. God’s saving love and life comes to us through the word that Jesus speaks to us. The true and faithful disciple hears the word and understands it. It engenders a spiritual renewal, which translates hearing into action. As noted by one spiritual writer, obstacles to this renewal through the word are disobedience to the Father’s will made known to us through Jesus Christ, external pressures and over-involvement in other affairs crowds out the more important things.

16th Sunday – July 20th

“...The good seeds are the children of the Kingdom...” Once again, Jesus uses a parable to drive home the mystery of the Kingdom. Through baptism, we became adopted sons and daughters of God, brothers and sisters of Christ and of one another. The word of God nourishes us and helps us to stay on the path to holiness and righteousness. To be righteous is to be obedient to this word given to us by Jesus and to be in a good relationship with God and our brothers and sisters.

17th Sunday – July 27th

“...In his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.” The images in today’s gospel illustrate that we have discovered the find of a lifetime in the Kingdom, in Jesus Who manifests the life and love of God. And what do we do with it? We invest all of ourselves in it and make it the center of our life. Today, we are reminded of the preciousness of our faith and the need for us to be committed and to take seriously our relationship with Jesus Christ.
