

The Peace of Christ

We hear of one of the most fascinating post-resurrection appearances of Jesus to the disciples in today's gospel. Heart-broken and distraught, the apostles locked themselves up in a room for fear of the Jews. The risen Jesus appeared to them and greeted them: "Peace be with you!" Like the apostles we are gathered today and we could hear Him say to us individually "Peace be with you"! Today Christ comes to us personally proclaiming peace; peace in every heart, peace in every home, peace in our world!

Divine Mercy Sunday

Today is observed as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the Jubilee Year 2000, Saint John Paul II established this new feast to re-emphasize the tremendous gift of Divine Mercy that the Lord wants to pour out on each and every one of us. We experience this unfathomable mercy of God in a special way in the confessional. Jesus himself gives us these powerful words through St. Faustina: "When you approach the confessional, know this, that I myself, I'm waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest for I myself act in your soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of mercy. Every time you go to confession, immerse yourself entirely in my mercy with great trust so that I may pour the bounty of my peace upon your soul."
