Year Of Mercy

The Jubilee Year of Mercy begins this Tuesday, December 8, 2015, the feast of Immaculate Conception and ends on November 20, 2016, the feast of Christ the King. The Year of Mercy, called by Pope Francis, is an opportunity for us to encounter the incredible mercy of God. It is a time for the Church to focus on forgiveness and healing in a special way. During this Holy Year, our Holy Father challenges each and every one of us "to be a witness of mercy" by reflecting on and practicing the spiritual and corporal works of mercy.

Archbishop Prendergast has asked the faithful of the archdiocese to perform at least one spiritual or corporal work of mercy during this Year of Mercy. In the sacrament of reconciliation, we experience the loving and forgiving mercy of God. The archbishop encourages us to go to confession at least once this year. In his words, "this is a graced encounter that brings inner healing, peace and joy."
