

Pastor's Corner

"Rejoice, Jerusalem...be joyful all who are mourning." (Is. 66:10-11)

The fourth Sunday of Lent is traditionally known as "Laetare Sunday". Laetare is the Latin word for "Rejoice". Therefore, this day is a day of rejoicing. Why? Because our salvation, our liberation from sin and death is close at hand. When we think of the love that God our father has lavished upon us by letting us be called His children, by sending His Son as an atonement for our sins, we cannot but be filled with joy. In Jesus, the only begotten Son of God, we see the face of God's mercy. A thing of great joy!

The Forgiving Father

Our gospel today presents us with this classic story: the parable of the prodigal son. What a story! I have always found this story very powerful, moving and challenging. It is no mistake that the church presents us with this parable during this time of Lent to think and to reflect upon the love and mercy of God our father. I don't think more should be said about this parable. Perhaps we should just listen to it in our quiet moment and determine which role we play! This is the Jubilee Year of Mercy and the Holy Father has challenged us to do two things: receive God's mercy and share that mercy with others. So as you reflect on this parable, think of whom you need to forgive and ask for the grace to do that ASAP.
