

**Readings: Am 6:1a, 4-7/1 Tm 6:11-16/Lk 16:19-31**

*How oblivious is the rich man in our gospel today? First, he never sees Lazarus at his door. And then, when he is in torment, he still thinks he is better than Lazarus and orders him to fetch him water. He is oblivious to the fact that he can no longer make any difference, either for himself or for those in his family who await a similar fate. This is the danger of riches. We become comfortable and think we are in control. The parable today is a warning for all of us to look at our lives and how we follow Christ's commandment to love and care for the poor among us.*
