***How great is the mercy we have received—
and how much have we been forgiven?***

Yet how often do we lose our patience and lash out at those who have wronged us, disappointed us, or simply inconvenienced us? How easily can we hold on to resentment toward those who continually annoy or frustrate us, telling ourselves that they do not deserve our forgiveness? Sometimes the hurt is small and repeated. At other times, there may be one deep offense that has wounded us greatly. We may say that we have forgiven the person, yet find ourselves returning to the hurt again and again, struggling to truly let it go.

Perhaps this is where we need to remember the immeasurable mercy God has shown each of us. The forgiveness we have received from God is far greater than anything we could ever be asked to forgive another.
