DAY 1 Sun, SEP 8

OTTAWA – DUBROVNIK
Fly from Ottawa to Dubrovnik via Montreal and Vienna. Group
seating for our flight will be assigned by the airline.

Welcome to Croatia! Upon arrival in **Dubrovnik**, The Pearl of the Adriatic. We will collect our luggage and meet our English-speaking tour director. A brief journey will take us to our hotel where you can relax and get settled. We celebrate Mass and conclude the day with dinner and a restful night.

DAY 3 TUES, SEPT 10

Following breakfast, enjoy a walking tour of Old Town Dubrovnik, beginning with a visit to St. Blaise Church, dedicated to Saint Blaise, the patron saint of Dubrovnik. Continue to the Gothic and Renaissance-style Rector's Palace, home to the History Department of the Museum of Dubrovnik. Next, we stroll by the iconic Bell Tower Clock and Orlando's Column. To the left of this column is the Sponza Palace. Our final stop is the Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries. Enjoy lunch on your own at one of the many small restaurants along the narrow streets. The rest of your day is at leisure to explore the walled city or enjoy the beach. Dinner at leisure.

DAY 4 WED, SEPT 11 **EXCURSION TO MONTENEGRO** Depart for Montenegro, a small country boasting a dynamic landscape of extremely high peaks juxtaposed beside very deep canyons, caves, and bays. We head toward the mouth of the beautiful Bay of Kotor, the longest and deepest fjord in Southern Europe. Enjoy a boat ride to Our Lady of the Rocks, one of two islets off the coast of Perast. The Roman Catholic Church is the largest building on the artificial island made of rocks and old ships, created by a local fisherman who found the Blessed Mother and Jesus icon on a rock here. It is a tradition to throw rocks at the island to increase its size. Upon return to the coast, we stop in Perast, and explore this charming, old coastal town with just one main street, yet sixteen churches! Return to Breakfast, Dinner Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 Thurs, Sept 12 Dubrovnik - Wine Tasting - Split Depart Dubrovnik this morning and travel along the coast, stopping at the inlet of Peljesac for a wine tasting; continue the drive to Split. In the afternoon, explore the Diocletian's Palace and the Cathedral of St. Domnius in Split, offering a glimpse into the rich history and architectural splendor of this ancient city. This historical UNESCO World Heritage town will mesmerize you with the abundance of unique things to see and do. This evening, we'll take you to a local Konoba (tavern) for a leisurely local meal. Overnight in Split.

Today, travel from Split to Bosnia. Visit the city of Mostar with its historic bridge and old bazaar with cobblestone streets. In the afternoon, continue to Medjugorje, a revered pilgrimage site where the Virgin Mary is believed to have appeared to visionaries since 1981. This town has become a place of profound spiritual significance, attracting millions of pilgrims seeking peace, prayer, and spiritual renewal. We arrive at our hotel and get settled for 3 nights. In the evening, participate in a program consisting of the prayer of all three Mysteries of the Holy Rosary and the evening International Holy Mass. Afterward, we may participate in the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and

DAY 7 & 8 SAT + SUN, SEPT 14 + 15

We will spend two full days in Medjugorje. Our spiritual program consists of talks given by the Franciscans, daily Holy Mass, private devotion, a visit to Apparition Hill - site of the apparition of Our Lady, and a visit to the village Bijakovici from where all six visionaries come. Have a chance to meet with the visionaries, if they are in Medjugorje.
